To encourage creativity and imaginative play along with skill-based learning, here are some hands on activity suggestions for the week.

## Language is Fun!

### Materials Required:

- Books(with insect pictures)

### How to:

- Encourage the child to flip pages and identify the insects/creepy crawlies.
- Encourage the child to use the pointer finger and track the words from left to right as he/she reads.



## Tongs and pom poms!

### Materials Required-

- Pop poms
- Ice tray
- Tongs

### How to-

- Provide the child with ice trays.
- Let the child use tongs to place a pom-pom in each hole.



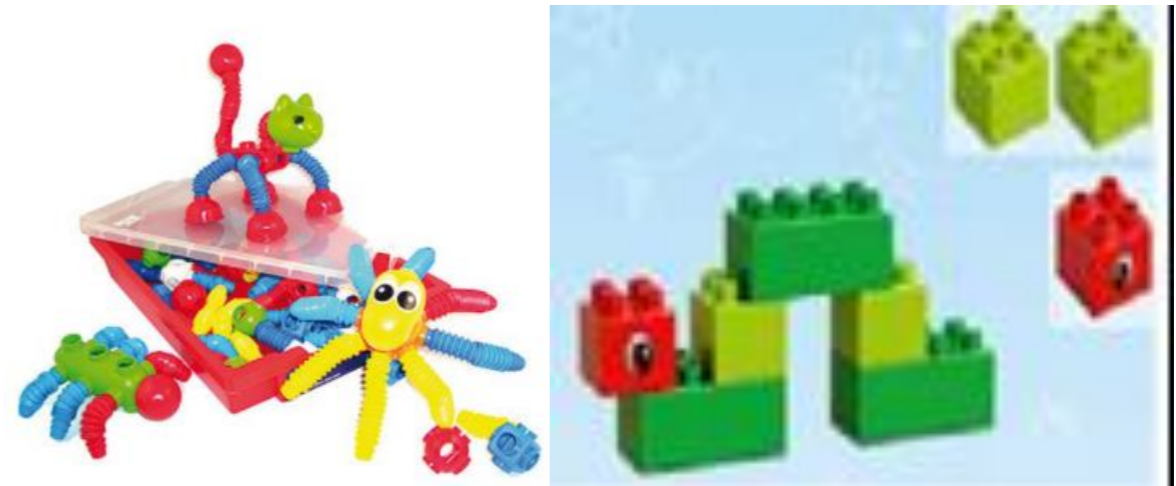
## Block fun!

### Materials Required-

- Popoid blocks/blocks

### How to-

- Let children make insects with the popoid blocks. If not available, you can even use regular blocks.
- Let the child place the blocks in a line to make creepy crawlies like an earthworm or a caterpillar.



## Playdough Insects/Creepy Crawlies

### Materials Required-

- Homemade / readymade playdough
- Reference pictures of insects /creepy crawlies

### How to-

- Provide the child with playdough
- Encourage the child to manipulate and roll playdough to make creepy crawlies and insects- caterpillar, spiders and/or worms.
