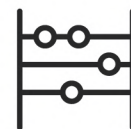

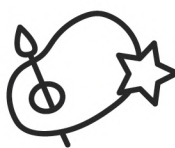

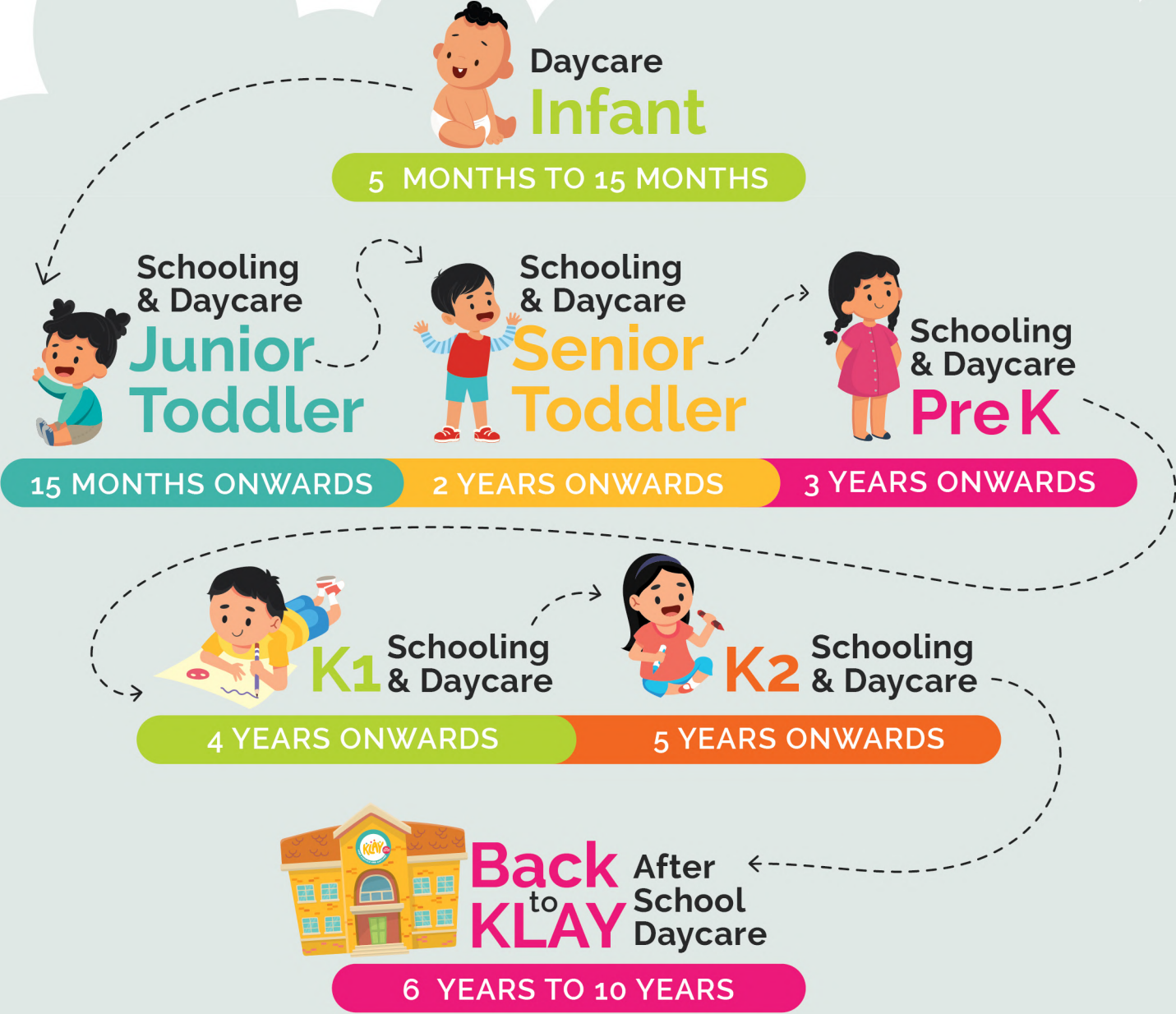

KLAY Preschools and Daycare is compliant with the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) standards.

We adhere to the following KLAY standards in all our centres across India:

SAFETY

Safety Always First @KLAY

Your child's safety has always been a top priority at KLAY.

- Our staff go through comprehensive and mandatory POCSO, Fire and First Aid Training.
- Every centre has its own Safety Officer to make sure that the resources and equipment at the centres are safety compliant and that the safety standards are adhered to.
- Our classrooms and outdoor areas come equipped with high quality equipment, Barton locks, finger guards and padded areas that safeguard your child from getting hurt.
- Every centre comes equipped with First Aid kits for both adults and children.
- Fire safety measures in place include extinguishers, smoke detectors and sprinkler systems
- There are CCTVs across all learning zones as well as voice recorders in the washrooms to ensure your child's safety.
- Your child is just a click away with CCTV access given to all parents during operational hours.

HYGIENE

We follow stringent health and hygiene standards at KLAY.

- All our centres are regularly cleaned and sanitized to maintain high levels of cleanliness.
- Children are checked for fever every day upon entry into the centre.
- We ensure all children have frequent hand-wash breaks
Toys, tools and frequently accessed areas are cleaned every day.
- Regular deep cleaning of toys and learning centres.
- Food is prepared in clean kitchens and all utensils are washed with warm water to ensure optimum hygiene at all times.
Our food safety measures in place include tasting before serving and a food handling manual.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Our centres are spacious, well lit and filled with age appropriate books, toys and learning aids.

- The classroom walls are transparent to give children a sense of space and safety at all times.
- Most of our centres have outdoor play areas, with safe, high quality equipment to ensure fun and safety!
- All our learning centres come equipped with soft padding, vinyl flooring and child friendly furniture.
